After our session, I will e-mail you with a request for payment of _____. I often adjust what I ask clients to pay because sometimes I tell stories, as part of a training session, and I don't feel clients should have to pay for those stories! So, I make time adjustments for that.

A typical length of time for a first session is often two hours, but I have no minimum, or maximum, time set for sessions. How long we work together is entirely up to you. In ongoing training sessions, working for an hour is common.

About me:

I have an extensive behavioral science education that is continually ongoing and deep history with LGDs, including my own. I have owned, or done training with, over 300 Maremmas, and other LGD breeds, over the last several years. There are typically 20+ Maremmas employed here on my 360-acre Oregon ranch. I use my LGDs and count on them! I know a lot about what it takes to create trustworthy working dogs.

Reasons to work with an LGD specialist certified trainer:

Are you considering the purchase of an LGD?

Talking with me before you buy, including before you decide on a breeder to work with, will help you understand what to look for in a breeder, and in a pup. Talking about how to create the appropriate infrastructure for LGDs, before you bring them home, is very wise. Creating a plan for how to manage the new pup in the first hours, days, and weeks in his/her new home can be critical to your success with your pup(s). In the US, 30% of LGDs fail; most of these "failed" are euthanized due to learned aggression, which is a product of mismanagement by humans. Protect your pups!

Are you an owner of LGDs who would like to have a deeper relationship with your dogs?

Understanding the language of dogs – how dogs learn – and adding "tools" to an owner's toolbox can significantly change the quality of life for both the dog and the owner, as well as help to make sure your dog doesn't become one of the 30% mentioned above.

Would you like troubleshooting help with your LGD(s)?

Problem-solving with me will help you protect your dog(s), and your livestock, and bring you peace of mind. LGDs are very difficult to re-train, so reaching out to me as soon as behaviors you are worried about begin, rather than waiting a week or two, is advisable.
